- There will be an annual district-wide review of the Parent Engagement policies and procedures.
- There is a district FACE committee, a school FACE committee, and a parent help organization (PATHS).

- Parent Engagement practices and Professional Learning Community practices will be observed by the district personnel. Professional Learning Community meetings will discuss parent engagement and forms of communication.
- Information that is sent home with students will be in a form that parents can understand. (ie. translated into the home language)
- Our school will be monitored by the district administration to ensure that we construct and maintain good communication and opportunities for Parent Engagement.
- Our school will provide services and information for parents to support academic achievement.
- Our school encourages parents to visit/volunteer with our PATHS group (Parents and Teachers Helping Students).
- Our school provides various meetings at various times in order for more parental participation.
- Our school provides a Parent Center, located in the Library Media Center, which provides resources for parents to learn about child development, child-rearing practices, and academic strategies in order to be a full partner in the education of their child.
- Our school will work with community partners to ensure each child has the resources they need.
- Surveys will be used to gather information regarding parental input and will be done annually or more frequently.
- Parents will be involved in the development of evaluation procedures for the FACE plan. Sign-in sheets will be provided, and the school will maintain this documentation.
