- 4. Parents are encouraged to contact their teacher with any academic or behavioral concerns. In addition, parents and teachers complete parent involvement forms to address student successes and concerns. Parents are given a summary of their assessments, as well as an explanation of interventions that are provided to assist in their child reaching their academic potential. Parents are also provided with suggestions to help enhance home to school communication as well as how to help address homework and grading procedures. If additional concerns need to be addressed, parents are encouraged to address these concerns with administration. Teachers of each grade level have weekly collaborative meetings to address students' needs.
- 5. Math and Science Elementary will conduct an annual evaluation of the effectiveness of the Parent and Family Engagement Plan and Parent and Family Engagement activities.
